BALTIKA №2 PALE

This European-style pilsner is straw-coloured with a medium body. It is the only Baltika beer brewed with added rice. Hop bitterness, flavour, and aroma are in the low to medium range. The residual malt sweetness does not predominate but can be perceived.

BALTIKA №3 CLASSIC

Classical European-style lager brewed since 1992. The oldest and most famous of the Baltika line. It is a medium-bodied beer with a constituent malt character balanced with a detectable hop note, without entailing excessive hop bitterness. The mouth feel can be characterized as light, crisp and dry, while the after-taste includes a hint of elite hop flavour.

BALTIKA №4 ORIGINAL

A typical Vienna-style lager produced since 1993. Brewed with a balanced blend of rye and caramel barley malts, this beer is reddish brown in colour, medium in body and characterized with a slight malt sweetness and crisp hop bitterness.

A premium European golden lager brewed with a fine blend of pilsner and caramel barley malts. The hop flavour is significant and of noble varieties, the bitterness is moderate, and both are backed by a solid malt body and sweetish notes from an all-malt base.

BALTIKA №6 PORTER

A traditional Baltic Porter first brewed for New Year's Eve 1995. Very dark in colour, Baltika №6 has a really smooth layered character with a distinctive note of roasted malt and dark sugars. Due to its alcoholic strength, the aroma includes gentle lager fruitiness, complex alcohols and just a hint of hops.

BALTIKA №7 EXPORT

Brewed as a traditional Dortmunder, this premium beer offers a light, crisp and very refreshing taste combined with a medium body. This beer is characterized with a lower hop background than Pilsners while higher than Helles. Palate fullness is easily detected with a smooth and aromatic flavour. The first batch was brewed in Finland by Santa Karina Brewery and dedicated to the 1994 St. Petersburg Goodwill Games.

BALTIKA №8 WHEAT

This South German-style Hefeweizen has been brewed since 2001 and produced with a fine blend of malted wheat, pilsner barley and caramel malts. Hop rates are quite low, but the yeast content provides a decidedly fruity aroma. This medium-bodied, pale amber beer also possesses a yeast flavour, a characteristically fuller mouth feel and a visibly cloudy appearance.

BALTIKA №9 EXTRA LAGER

European strong lager brewed since 1998. The strongest beer produced under the Baltika label. With a high original gravity and alcohol content, this beer approaches the strength of a Bock. Some residual sweetness is detectable. The hop content is quite low, contributing little bitterness and virtually no hop aroma. A taste of sweet-fruity esters and complex alcohols is incorporated into a solid and complete body.

BALTIKA COOLER

Launched in 2006, this beer is the most recent sub-brand of Baltika. A traditional American lager, brewed with added corn, and light in body and colour. Flavour components are subtle and complex, with no one ingredient dominating the others. Hop bitterness, flavour and aroma are quite light.
